Congratulations to all councils who chose to show their rainbow colours this Pridevember!

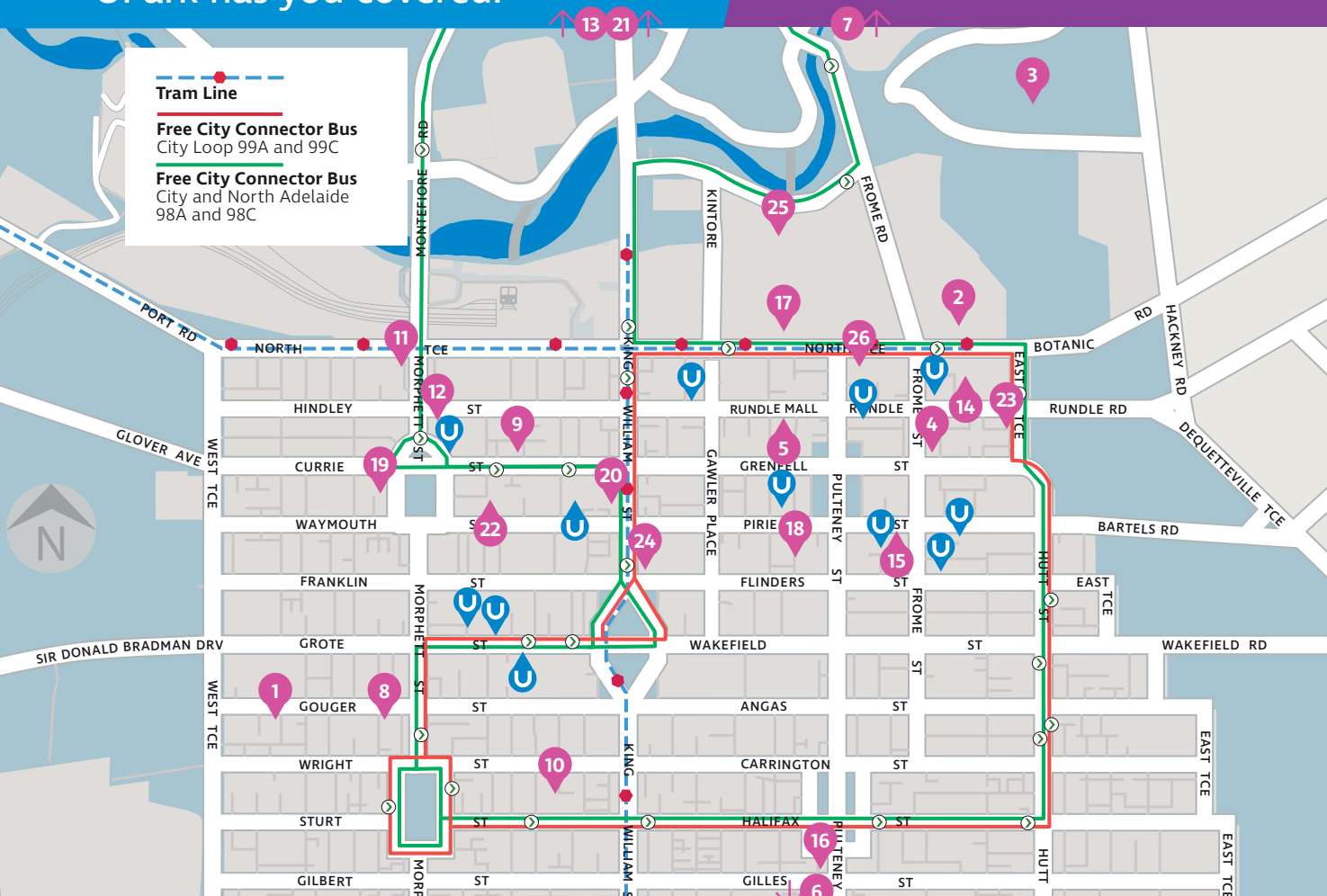
